



RAIN SHADOW EFFECT.

When moist warm air meets a mountain range, it rises, cools, and creates clouds that rain on the windward side of the mountain. The air then becomes drier as it descends the opposite leeward side of the mountain. Few clouds reach the leeward side, so it is relatively dry. Astoria lies near the Pacific Coast on the windward side of the Cascade Range, while Sunnyside lies on the leeward side.
